Freshman Scholarships

- Scholarships are based on high school GPA, recalculated on a 4.0 scale and weighted for honors/dual credit/AP/IB courses.

- Scholarships are based on cumulative college GPA.

FINANCIAL AID

McMurry offers many forms of financial aid, such as University scholarships and grants, state grants, federal grants, outside scholarships and work-study opportunities. Over 99% of students receive some type of financial assistance, and this year McMurry distributed over \$11 million in financial aid.

Our financial aid package for students represents the best and most equitable award we can make, based on the information you and your family submit, the completion date of the file, academic performance and the availability of funds.

Fine Arts Scholarships

- Scholarships up to \$2,500 per year for students involved in Band, Choir, Theater, or Art.

Honors Program Scholarships

- Students accepted into the Honors Program receive additional scholarships ranging from \$3,000 per year up to covering the full cost of tuition.

United Methodist Scholarships

- Scholarships ranging from \$1,000–\$3,000 are available for students who are active members of a United Methodist Church.
- Additional scholarships are available for dependents of United Methodist ministers.

Endowed Scholarships

- Students may apply for endowed scholarships during the spring of their freshman, sophomore and junior years. These scholarships will take effect the following academic year. Endowed scholarships are funded by generous supporters of McMurry and range up to \$5,000.
- Departmental scholarships are awarded for outstanding achievements each year.

*Books may be charged to the student account at the McMurry Bookstore. Estimated annual bookstore charges are \$1,200.

*McMurry charges tuition at a block rate per academic year (fall & spring), for students taking 12 or more hours per semester.

WORK-STUDY OPPORTUNITIES

On-campus work-study positions are offered for students who qualify through federal and state work-study and the McMurry work program. Work-study is a taxable wage paid directly to the student and averages 10 hours per week.

NEED-BASED AID

Federal and State Grants: Based on need shown on the FAFSA.

- Pell: up to \$6,495
- SEOG (zero EFC): \$1,000
- Texas Equalization Grant (TEG): \$3,497 per year

McMurry Grants: Based on need demonstrated on the FAFSA, McMurry may award additional grants to students. Amounts are based on need.

Federal Direct Loans: All students who file the FAFSA are eligible for federal direct loans. Amounts will vary based on need and classification.
